



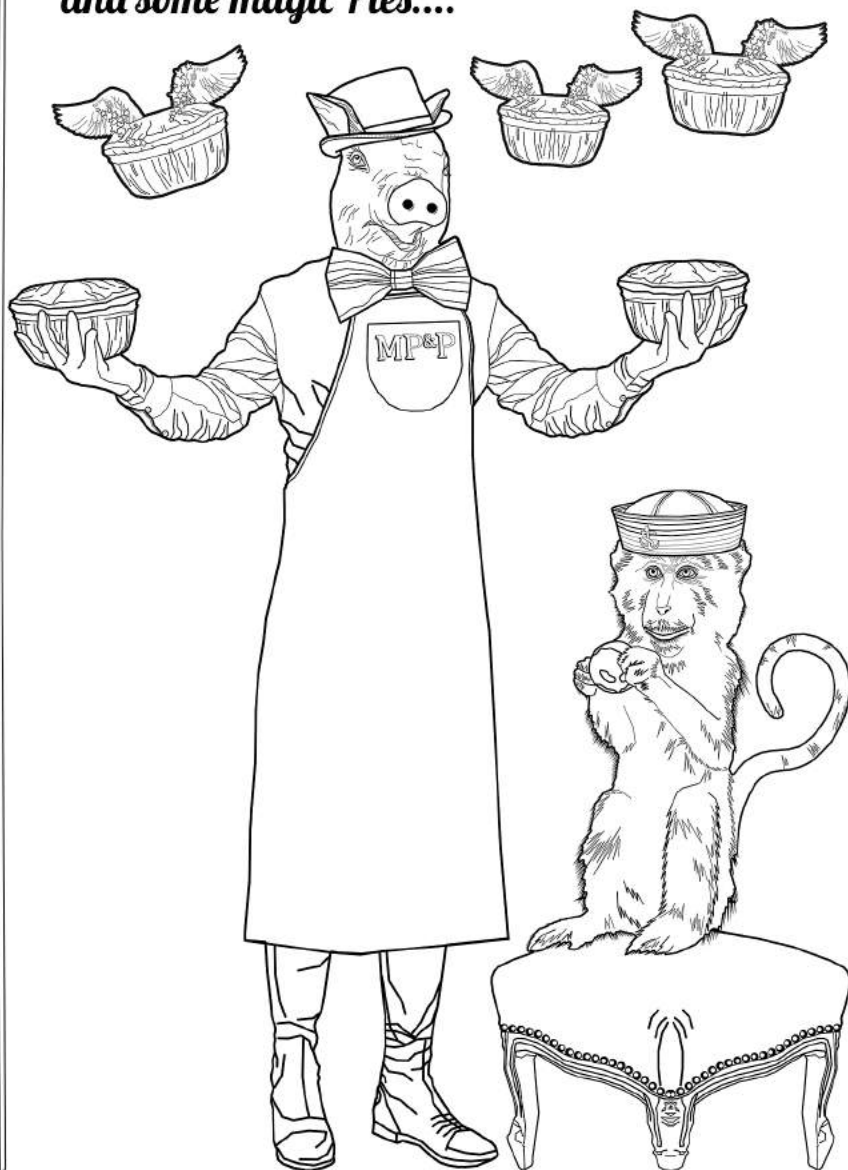

MONKEY, PIG AND PIE PAPER SHOP



1. Using coloured card or paper make your shop background.



2. Create your characters .



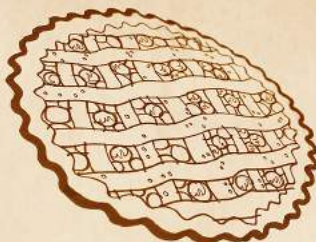
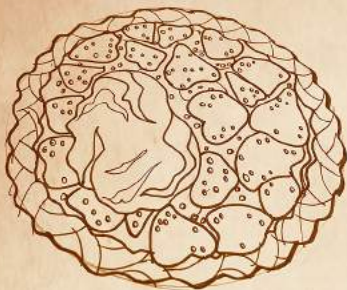
3. Cut some strips and four small triangles of cardboard from an old box or cereal box.



4. Glue the strips of cardboard to the back of your background and characters. Attach the cardboard triangles to allow them to stand up.

These magic pies can transport you to a place of your choosing.

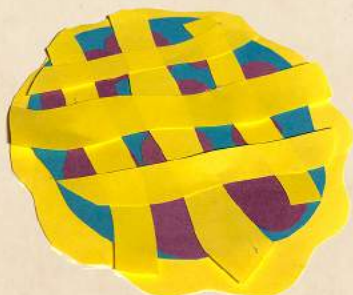
CREATE YOUR OWN MAGIC PIES

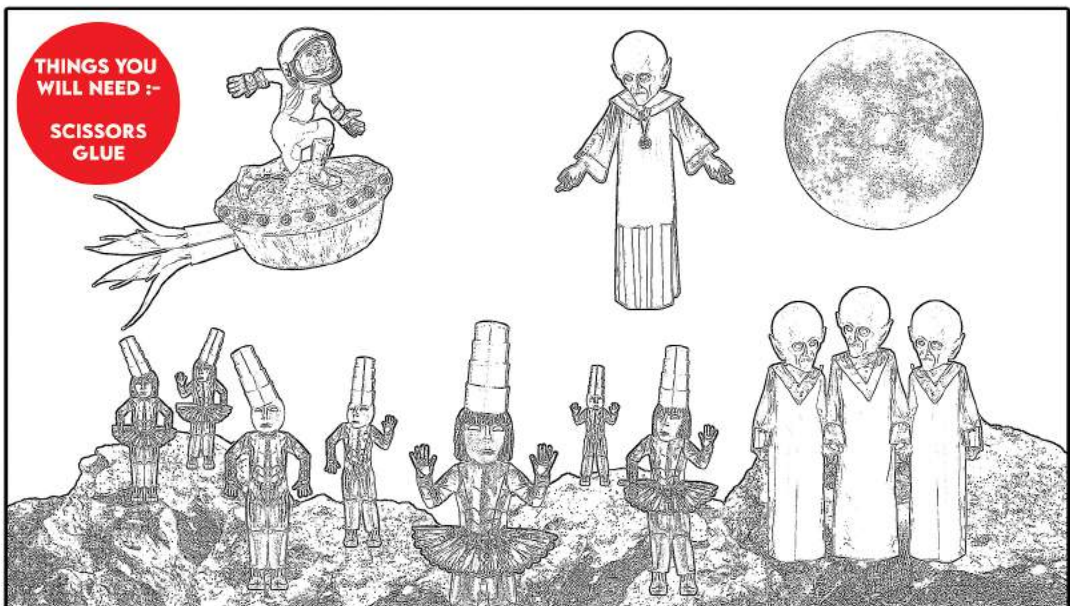


FLYING ON HIS MAGIC PIE THE MONKEY ARRIVES IN SPACE!

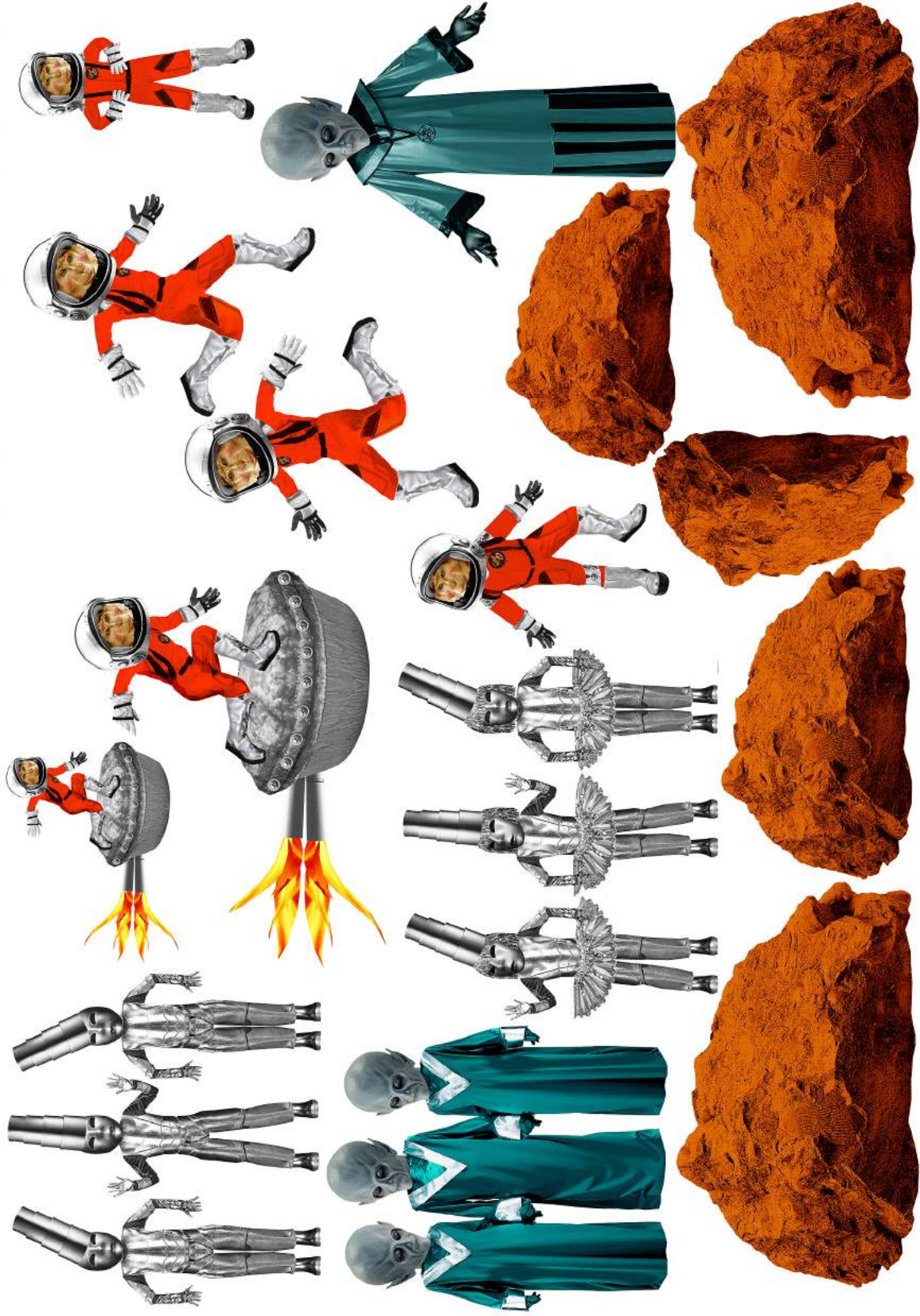
Draw your own version of the Monkey in Space.
These drawings can then be cut out / coloured in / animated.

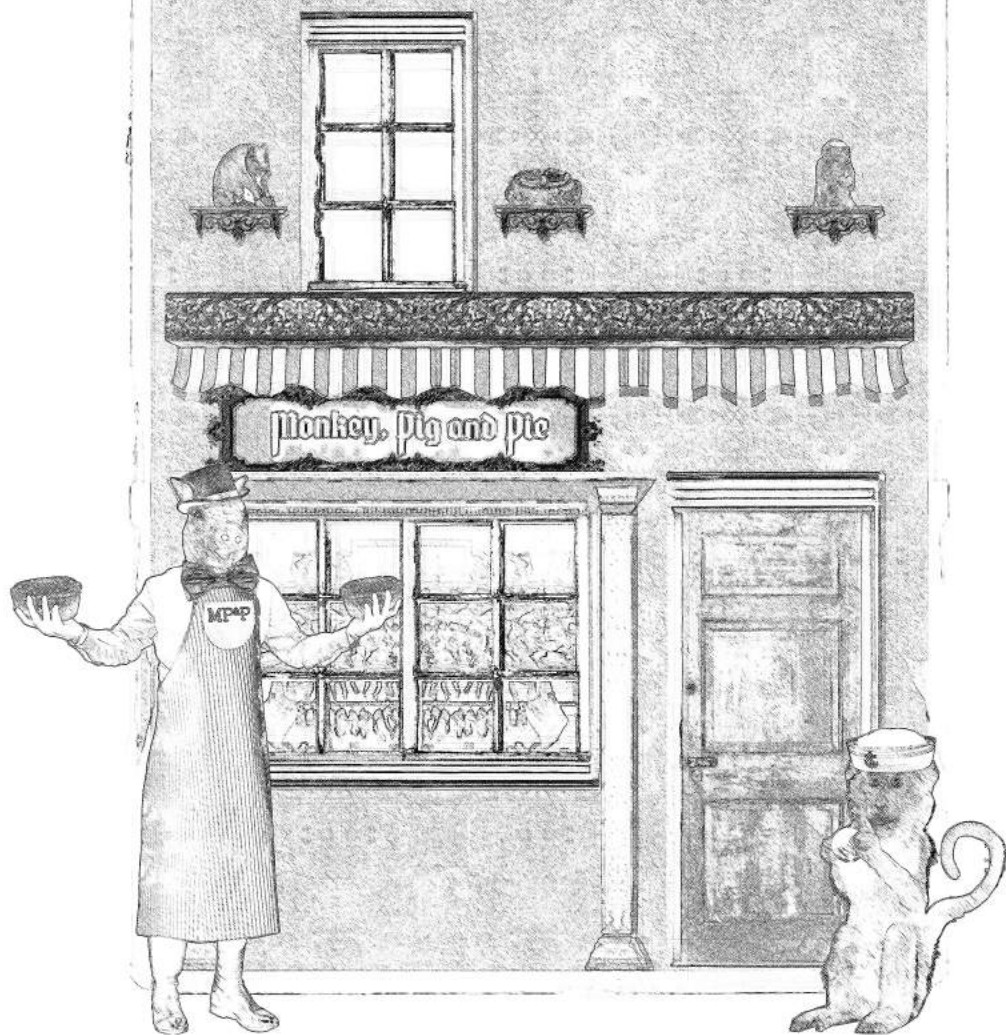
* If you want to experiment with creating some writing or a poem where do you imagine the Monkey might travel? What will happen when he arrives?

Fletcher's Pork Butchers (1860-1950's) was situated on the corner of East St Mary's Gate and Victoria Street, it was known as the 'Monkey Pig and Pie Shop'. There were stone models of a monkey, a pig and a pie on the outside of the shop. The pig and pie are traditional symbols of pork butchers, there are various versions of why there was also a stone monkey. One story is that one day a sailor ran into the shop and shouted "They're after me! Look after my monkey!" The sailor never returned for the monkey. When the monkey died a statue was added to remember its life.
